Students for a Democratic Society (SDS)

Case Creation Date:

- March 2, 2026

Incident Summary:

- *On February 17, 2026, from 12:00–1:30 p.m., Students for a Democratic Society (SDS) held a protest titled “No Jobs for Genocide” opposing the presence of Lockheed Martin, General Dynamics, and HP at the STEM Career Fair. The demonstration began outdoors near Clark Hall before six participants entered the Student Union, bypassed stanchions near the Ballroom, and engaged in amplified chanting and flyer distribution despite multiple warnings for violating Time, Place, and Manner policies and creating egress concerns.*

Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:

- (08) Failure to Comply
 - (A) Failure to comply with the directions of University officials acting in the performance of their official duties.
 - (C) Failure to follow all policies and procedures established by the University pertaining to student organizations, including fraternities and sororities, as outlined in the Student Organizations Handbook.
- (16) Obstruction of University Activities
 - Behavior which disrupts or interferes with normal University or University sponsored activities, including, but not limited to, study, teaching, research, officially invited speakers, University administration, public safety, fire, police or emergency services, or other authorized activity. Such behavior includes abridgement of rights to freedom of speech and expression.

Sanctions:

- **Complete a Follow Up Meeting by May 1, 2026.**

- **Extended Probation at the University from September 22, 2025 to March 22, 2027, with the following terms.**
